Scriptures



- Two categories of shastras
 - **Paroksha** Shastras and **Pragat** Shastras
- Over 300 sat-shastras of which eight have been endorsed
- Vachanamrut Vadtal 18 and Shikshapatri Shloka 93-95
- You must know these *and* shastras of the Sampraday



8 sat-shastras



- 4 Vedas – Rig, Saam, Atharva, Yajur
- Vyas Sutra
- Srimad Bhagwat Puran
- Vishnu Sahasranam (Mahabharat)
- Srimad Bhagwat Geeta
- Vidoor Niti
- Vasudev Mahatmay (Skandh Puran)
- Yagnavalkya Smriti



Shastras of the Sampraday



- Shikshapatri
 - 212 shlokas written by God Himself
 - Written in Vadatal on Maha Sud 5 (vasant panchami) Samvat 1882
 - The scripture of the Sampraday
 - Means to attaining ultimate happiness
- Vachanamrut (Hari Vakya Sudha Sindhu)
 - 273 Prakarans of discourses delivered in the presence of Maharaj in 9 different towns/villages
 - Documented by Gopalanand, Muktanand, Brahmanand, Nityanand and Shukanand Swami



Shastras of the Sampraday



- Srimad Satsangi Jeevan
 - 5 Prakran, 360 Adhyay and 19,387 shlokas
 - Written by Shatanand Swami by the instruction of Maharaj
 - Recited by Suvrat Swami to King Pratap Sinh
 - Biography of Maharaj
- Shree Hari Digvijay
 - Accounts of debates Maharaj had with various scholars and pandits
 - Written by Nityanand Swami in Sanskrit



Shastras of the Sampraday



- **Desh Vibhag Lekh**
 - Constitution of the Sampraday
 - Dictated by Maharaj to Shukanand Swami
- **Srimad Satsangi Bhushan**
 - 5 ansh, 261 adhyay written by Vasudevanand Varni
 - Pass times of Maharaj recited by Vyapkesh Muni to King Jeshtajit and Brahmanand Swami to Shiv Ram Vipra
 - Focusses on bhakti, particularly of the satsangi females



Shastras of the Sampraday



- Nishkulanand Kavya
 - Collection of 22 scriptures written by Nishkulanand Swami in poetic form
 - Includes Purushottam Prakash, Dheeraj Akhyan, Yamdund, Vachan Vidhi etc.
- Shikshapatri Artha Dipika
 - Commentary on Shikshapatri written by Shatanand Swami
